

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **How can I register for Rider's Edge?**

Please call Dave Cheatham at 410-263-3345 x 225 to pick your class. We register continually for classes starting in March and going thru December.

### **Do I need a motorcycle learner's permit?**

No at this time you need only a valid drivers license or learners permit for cars.

### **Do I receive my class M (motorcycle license) at the end of class?**

You will take the written and riding test with us. Upon successfully completing both tests you will receive a certificate to take to the MVA to pick up your M sticker.

### **My job requires me to be there until 6 pm, so I will be late for class.**

Sorry. Classes begin promptly as scheduled. You must be in class on time as scheduled or forfeit class and registration fee. A new class will only be given with a new registration fee.

### **What do I need to bring to class?**

You will need a DOT certified helmet. We recommend a full-face helmet but a half or three quarter style is acceptable. Also full-fingered gloves, long sleeve shirt or jacket, over the ankle boots or shoes, and eye covering. Eye covering can be your glasses, goggles, or the face shield on your helmet.

### **Do I have to bring my motorcycle to class?**

No. We furnish a motorcycle to train on. It is a 492 cc Buell Blast. This is a sit up comfortably type motorcycle that is fun to ride.

### **What happens if I don't pass the test?**

The state allows 30 days to retake either test at no additional charge/ This will be done thru us.

### **How many students in a class?**

Most classes will have 10 students, some will have only 6.

### **What happens if it rains?**

Delays do happen at times. We will adjust hours or schedule make up days as soon as possible.

### **What experience do I need for this course?**

This course is designed with the beginner in mind. We take a building block approach to teaching. This means we start with one small skill and keep adding new skills a step at a time until you have it all. We make it fun and easy.

**What is the difference in the Harley-Davidson, Rider's Edge class and the other classes offered in the state?**

The Rider's Edge course is a 25-hour course compared to a 17-hour course given by other providers. This gives us more time riding the motorcycle and we have time for more one on one teaching for those who need it. We are committed to having a positive learning experience and having a large amount of fun at the same time.

**I have been riding for 10 years and need to get my license, is this the course for me?**

Yes. There are many things that cannot be learned by riding only. We have many students who come back with the comment that " I thought I knew how to ride, I can't believe how much I learned and had fun too."

**What will I get out of this class in addition to my class M license?**

Our goal is to: Develop a safe and responsible motorcyclist.

Develop the mental skills for safe motorcycling.

Develop the physical skills for safe motorcycling.

Create an understanding of risk awareness and risk taking.

Develop a strategy to manage risk.

To have fun while doing all of the above.

At registration, \$15.00 off a \$100.00 of more purchase for your new rider riding gear (must be done before class starts).

At graduation, a Gift Certificate for \$50.00 on a \$250.00 purchase of Motor clothes or parts.

When you purchase a Motorcycle from us just before or just after Successfully completing the class we will refund your entire class tuition to your HD/B of Annapolis account to buy motor clothes or parts.

**Where are the classes held?**

The first two nights are in the HD/B of Annapolis Dealership.

The two full days are held at Tipton Airport in Odenton, at the intersection of Rt. 32 and Rt. 198.

**Will I get a discount on my motorcycle insurance?**

Some insurance companies give discounts others do not. This course qualifies for those companies that have the discount.
