Or 13 km west of Bently on Highway # 12 to the Ski Hill, then North on Range Road 2-5, 18 km to the correction line.





About Us

The Rimbey layout plays at 2862 yards, par 35, through varying tree-lined, narrow, and wide fairways, elevation and the river. From an elevated tee box on number one, through a tree lined chute, crossing the river, a challenging warm-up hole. Two boasts 486 yards along the Blindman River. Number three is a bit unnerving water to a large, elevated, front-sloping green, guarded back and sides by trees. If you are lucky enough to land above the pin, you are left with a very difficult comeback putt.

Holes five through eight play through heavily treed, rolling terrain, leading to a nice finishing hole at nine. plays to a green hidden by the hill necessitating a blind approach shot.

From the sheltered, heavily treed area in the west to open space to the east, the campground offers rustic and conveniently located in close proximity to the clubhouse. Horseshoe pitch, fire pits.

Members that log the most miles during our riding season will be announced at our AGM in November and prizes will be awarded.
